December 21, 1933 - November 18, 2018

Kenneth J. Allen, M.D. of Wheeling, died November, 18, 2018, he was 84.

Dr. Allen grew up in Moundsville, WV; and was the son of Clarence Allen and Bertha Broemsen Allen.

He was a 1951 graduate of Moundsville High School and studied pre-medicine at Marshall University before attending West Virginia University School of Medicine, where he received his B.S. Degree in 1956. He was graduated from Temple University School of Medicine in 1958 with his M.D. Degree.

Post-graduate training included Hannemann Medical College, Philadelphia, PA, Cook County Graduate School of Medicine, Chicago, IL, Western Pennsylvania Hospital, Pittsburgh, PA, Magee Women's Hospital, Pittsburgh, PA, University of Colorado School of Medicine, Denver, CO, Tufts School of Medicine, Boston, MA, and the Harvard University School of Medicine, Boston, MA.

Dr. Allen served in private practice in Marshall County, since 1960, first practicing with William Paul Bradford, M.D. Dr. Allen moved his private practice to Glen Dale, WV in 1969.

His affiliations included the West Virginia Medical Association and the American Medical Association. He was a member of the Southern Medical Association, the American Academy of Family Physicians, where he was awarded Fellow status in 1972 as a Charter Fellow. He was a Board Certified member of the American Board of Family Practice and a member of the West Virginia Obstetrical Society.

Dr. Allen was affiliated with Reynolds Memorial Hospital since 1960. He was a member of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology, and Chief of Services, 1984 being his latest term. He was a past president of the medical staff and chaired most hospital related committees over the years.

He served as the Physician Director of the Marshall County Health Department from 1996 until 2016.

Dr. Allen also was a Medical Director at the Health Plan of the Upper Ohio Valley until his retirement from that position.

Recently, he served as a Preceptor at the Family Medical Department, Wheeling Hospital. Dr. Allen was a member of many boards and local organizations.

He was preceded in death by his first wife, Adelaide Allen.

Surviving are his wife, Dorcas C. Allen and three children from his first marriage, Jeffrey Allen (Laura) of Charleston, WV, Colleen Allen of Hawaii, and Deborah Davison (Ted) of Richfield, OH. Also surviving are his sister, Mrs. Barbara Cuichta of Glen Dale, WV and a brother Robert Allen (Ruth) of Bridgeport, WV.

There will be no visitation. A private service will be held at the convenience of the family.
