Robert "Bob" Flowers, 94, of Bethlehem, died Wednesday, June 26, 2019 in Good Shepherd Nursing Home, Wheeling.

He was born January 21, 1925 in Moundsville, WV; the son of the late Benjamin and Viola Flowers.

He was a US Navy veteran of WWII; manager for Garvin's Dairy for 19 years and Coronet Foods for 19 years; a member of the First Baptist Church in Wheeling, and Masonic Lodge 5, Wheeling.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a sister, Betty Lofton; and a brother, Lyle Flowers.

Survivors include his wife of 65 years, Helen Lipan Flowers; a son, Ed (Patty) Flowers of Bethlehem; a step-daughter, Linda Jordan of Arizona; 14 grandchildren; 5 great-grandchildren; 2 great-great-grandchildren; several nieces and nephews.
