



Ronald J. DiLorenzo

December 10, 1947 - August 3, 2019

Ronald Jacob DiLorenzo, 71, of Wheeling died on Saturday morning, August 3, 2019 peacefully at home surrounded by his loving family.

Known as Ron, Ronnie, DiLo or Mr. D. by his beloved students, he was born December 10, 1947 in Steubenville, Ohio and raised in Weirton, WV.

Ron graduated from Weir High School in 1965 and received his undergraduate and advanced degrees from WVU.

He is the son of Armeda DiLorenzo and the late Paul DiLorenzo.

Ron married his loving wife of 48 years, Roberta "Robbie" in 1971.

He was an active member of St. Michael's Church and served as Eucharistic Minister, Engaged Couples Sponsor and Confirmation instructor for many years.

After 42 years of service, Ron retired as Wheeling Park High School's Dean of Students/Chairperson of the Guidance Counseling Dept. Prior to counseling, he taught elementary music and was assistant band director. He was also a professional musician (since the age of 14) who played his trumpet and sang in numerous Ohio Valley bands, the most recent being the popular SHOP band. His reputation as an entertainer and an educator reflected his incredible musical talent and people skills.

He shared his time and talents with many and was a model of integrity, respect, love and laughter. He was a friend to all.

The WV Board of Education named Ron the 2007 WV Character Educator of the Year in recognition of his exemplary modeling and instilling character in his students. Wheeling Park High School honored Ron as the 1999-2000 Educator of the Year. Well-deserved tributes for a true gentleman and man of character – a good and honest man.

He is survived by his wife and four children: Cara (Terry) Netherton of Richmond, KY, Matt (Amy) DiLorenzo of Lexington, KY, Adria (Ron Scott) DiLorenzo of Wheeling, Nathan DiLorenzo of Detroit, MI. along with his eight grandchildren: Peyton and Haley Netherton, Dominic, Angelo and Gianna DiLorenzo, Luca DiLorenzo, D'asia and Lorenzo Scott. He is also survived by his mother Armeda and siblings Paula and Robert (Bob) DiLorenzo and numerous nieces, nephews and cousins.

Say not in grief he is no more but live in thankfulness that he was.
