Teresa Ann "Teri" Rine Hartle, age 63 of Moundsville, West Virginia, passed away at Reynolds Memorial Hospital on Tuesday, February 8, 2022.

Teri was born on September 20, 1958 at Reynolds Memorial Hospital in Moundsville. After graduating John Marshall High School in 1976, she studied Speech Pathology at West Liberty State College and Marshall University. Teri was employed with Marshall County Schools for 33 years as a speech therapist before retiring. After retirement, she worked for Head Start. Teri taught Sunday school as active member of Moundsville Baptist Church and was an avid crafter. Teri loved to travel and enjoyed walking on the beach collecting shells, and camping. Teri was foundational to her family; she absolutely loved children and doted on her grandchildren. She was deeply perceptive and a mother figure to all she met, with a rare ability to truly listen to and understand others.

Teri was preceded in death by her father Albert Marlo Rine and stepfather Dean Richmond; and is survived by her mother Phyllis Joan McDowell Richmond; her husband of 39 years James "Jim" William Hartle; sons James "Gavin" (Melissa) Hartle, of Wheeling, WV and Logan William (Sarabeth) Hartle, of Charlotte, NC; two grandchildren, Ellie Ana and Desmond Patrick; sisters Cindi (David) Bougher, Brenda (John) Lavenski, Marla (Richard) Truex, Traci (Dean) Goodnight, Lisa (William) Williams; and many nieces and nephews.


