Albert J. Warsinsky, age 98 formerly of McMechen, WV died Sunday, January 21, 2018 in Brickmont Assisted Living of Milton, GA.

He was born February 28, 1919 in Benwood, WV the son of the late Theodore and Ethel Chapman Warsinsky.

He was a member of St. James Catholic Church; worked at Wheeling-Pittsburgh Steel Corp., Benwood Plant until retiring and spending his winters in Port Charlotte, FL and summers in Fish Creek, WV; and he was a life-long member of the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks.
