Allison Lara Payne, 30, of Moundsville, lost her battle with anorexia and bulimia, which she battled for several years on Tuesday, August 2, 2016. She was born February 19, 1986 in Glen Dale, WV; the daughter of Kathy Payne of Moundsville and William Payne, Jr. of North Carolina.

Allison was a member of Hillview Terrace Church of Christ; 4-H; liked country music and going to Jamboree in the Hills; reading; but she loved being with her family most of all.

She was preceded in death by a sister Jessica Payne; maternal great-grandparents Nora and Randall Stewart; paternal grandparents William, Sr. and Anne Payne; cousin Cara Payne.
