Swierkos, Anna Mae Dobbs, 87, of Moundsville, died Friday, November 14, 2014 at home.

She was born October 19, 1927 on Nauvoo Ridge, Marshall County, WV, the daughter of the late Harry and Bessie West Dobbs.

She was co-founder of Swierkos Enterprise and a member of the Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints.

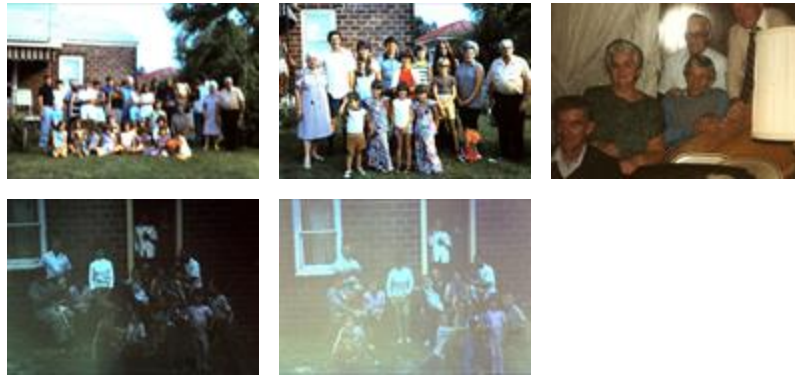
