



## Arthur N. "Art" LaFollett

Arthur N. "Art" LaFollett, age 65, of Powhatan Point, OH passed away peacefully at home, Thursday May, 10, 2018, surrounded by his family. He was born October 27, 1952 in Bellaire, Ohio, a son of the late Arthur T. and Nancy Stevens LaFollett.
