Barbara Ann Key, 84, of Wheeling, WV; died Wednesday, December 17, 2025 at WVU Wheeling Hospital, surrounded by her loving family.

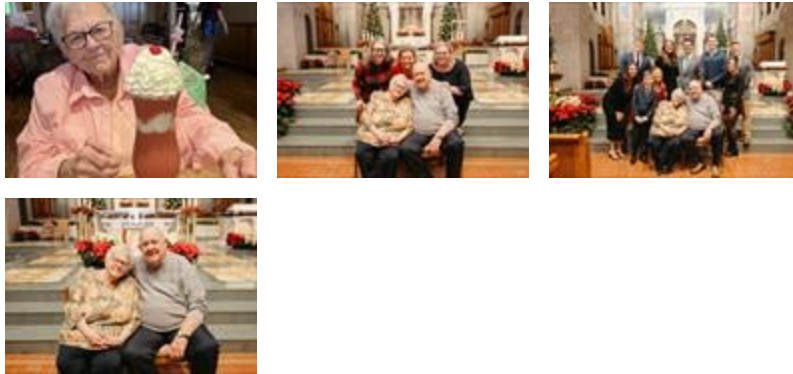
