Bernadene Ann Harris, age 85 of Bethlehem, passed away Sunday, December 12, 2021 at Good Shepherd Nursing Home, Wheeling. She was born October 19, 1936 in Weirton, WV daughter of the late Dr. E.L. and Lillian Hubbard Bails.
