Bohrer, Gregory S. "Flash", age 57, of Proctor, WV, died Thursday, September 13, 2012 at Wetzel County Hospital, New Martinsville.

He was born September 27, 1954 in New Martinsville, the son of David Bryce Bohrer and the late Velma Lucille McFadden Bohrer.

Flash was an equipment operator for CSX Railroad for 35 years. He was a member of Moose Lodge #931, New Martinsville, Proctor Christian Church, and a Board Member of the Spieler's Club in Proctor. Flash was President of the Magnolia Athletic Boosters for many years, devoting countless hours of his time to help the student athletes. He was an avid Magnolia Blue Eagle, WVU Mountaineer and Steeler fan.

He was preceded in death by his mother in 2003.
