Boston, Frederick H. age 76, of Hannibal, OH. died Friday, July 25, 2008 in Ruby Memorial Hospital, Morgantown, WV.

He was born August 12, 1931 in New Martinsville, WV, a son of the late Neville Victor and Edna Opal Wilt Boston.

He was a graduate of Hannibal High School and an active member in the Hannibal Alumni. He served in the U.S. Army from 1949 to 1953. He attended Ohio University from 1954 – 1958. His formal education included Purdue University, West Virginia State College, Kansas University and Ohio Wesleyan. He was a teacher in the Loudonville, OH School District until 1969, when he began teaching at River High School until his retirement in 1990.

He served on the board of the Monroe County Park District where some of his accomplished goals were to see a public pool in Hannibal and the establishment of Kiedaisch Point Park. He served on the Monroe County Planning Commission and the Monroe County Improvement Corporation. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by two brothers, David and Robert Boston and one sister, Mary Elizabeth Wayman.

Survivors include two brothers, Neville (Mary) Boston of Hannibal, Tom (Darlene) Boston of New Matamoras, OH, three sisters, Lucy Jamison of Concord CA, Marguerite Andersen of Hannibal, and Rosemary Boston of Livingston, Montana, two sisters-in-law Marian Boston of Concord, CA and Donna Boston of Columbus, OH, 21 nieces and nephews and many friends. There will be no visitation. Services will be held at the convenience of the
