



## Boyd E. Engle Jr.

December 12, 1924 - October 26, 2016

Boyd E. Engle, Jr., age 91 of Glen Dale, WV died Wednesday, October 26, 2016 in Ohio Valley Medical Center, Wheeling, WV.

He was born December 12, 1924 in Moundsville, WV the son of the late Boyd Engle, Sr. and Mae Williams Engle Torrey.

He was a WWII Army Veteran; having been MIA and a POW from October of 1944 through February of 1945; a retired school teacher and principal from Martins Ferry Schools; a member of Glen Dale United Methodist Church, the Barbed Wire Chapter of POW's; Ohio Retired Teachers Assoc., Disabled Veterans Assoc., and one of the originators of the Marshall County Hunting & Fishing Club.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Mary Ann Barr Engle; and a daughter, Mary Lynn Engle.

Survivors include two daughters, Elaine (Jim) Land of Ozark, AL, and Nancy Jane (Rick) Woods of Fork Ridge; a son, Thomas (Kathy) Engle of Moundsville; a brother, Charles D. (Ann) Engle of Yorktown, VA; five grandchildren, Rich (Lisa) Woods, T.J. (Beth) Woods, Matt Engle, Andrew (Molly) Engle, and Zachary Land; eight great-grandchildren, Abby, Isaac, Gracie and Hannah Woods, Kaitlyn and Laney Engle, and Jayce Land, and Kaylyn Holt; and several nieces and nephews.
