Bradley W. Murphy, age 74 of Moundsville, WV passed away Saturday, October 8, 2022 at home.

He was born February 25, 1948, the son of the late William G. and Jane Burkett Murphy.

Brad was a 1967 graduate of Moundsville High School, a former employee of the US Army Corps of Engineers, and a US Army Combat Veteran serving two tours in Vietnam and Purple Heart recipient.
