Brooks Brady "Boz" Bosworth, 54, of St. Clairsville, OH passed away suddenly on Wednesday, December 29, 2021 at Wheeling Hospital, Wheeling, WV.

He was born July 10, 1967 in Glen Dale, WV, son of the late William "Bill" Bosworth and Rosa Boone.

Brooks was a correctional officer for 24 years at Belmont County Correctional Institution, St. Clairsville; a devoted Cleveland Browns fan, hunter, golfer, and loved growing giant pumpkins, in which he was awarded King Pumpkin of Barnesville, OH in 2007.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his brother, Andy Bosworth and grandparents, Junior and Beverly Bosworth.
