Bruno Alesandro Bettinazzi, age 89 of Martins Ferry, OH died Wednesday, August 16, 2017 in Ruby Memorial Hospital, Morgantown, WV.

He was born February 27, 1928 in Seminole, PA the son of Louis and Palmira Viona Bettinazzi.

He spent 40 years working the coal mine, where he retired as a safety supervisor with Consol Energy Ireland Mine, Moundsville; was the owner/operator of the Prima Marina for 10 years, and once he retired from there, he spent his time golfing, bowling, traveling, and working on his farm. He enjoyed traveling to Vegas, and his home away from home, Wheeling Island Casino, who became his large extended family. He also spent 3 days a week with his Pulmonary Rehab Family at East Ohio Regional Hospital, where at times, they used laughter as the best medicine.

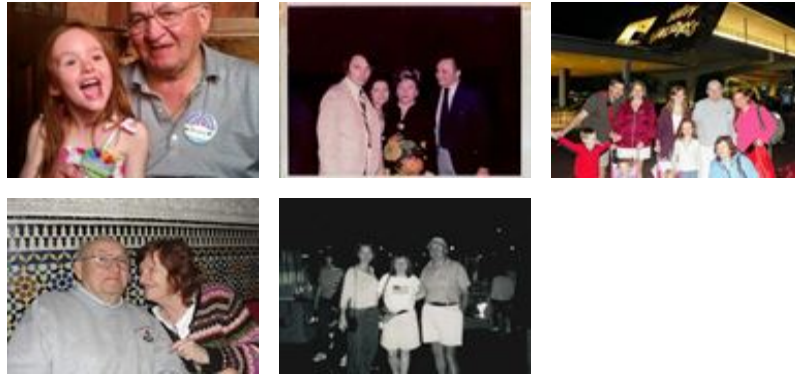
