Byron L. "Doc" Simmons, age 77 of Moundsville, WV passed away Thursday, December 2, 2021 in WVU Ruby Memorial Hospital, Morgantown, WV. He was born April 19, 1944 in Glen Dale, WV the son of the late Bernard R. and Eunice W. Reed Simmons.
