April 21, 1949 - March 31, 2014

Ivey, C. David, 64, of Sardis, Ohio, died Monday, March 31, 2014 at UPMC Shadyside Hospital, Pittsburgh, PA.

He was born April 21, 1949 in Maryville, TN, the son of the late John Adam and Marie (Hill) Ivey Merryman.

David was a U. S. Army Staff Sergeant during the Vietnam War from 1969 to 1970. He was a retired shift repairman at PPG and former co-owner of Sound Source in Sardis; a member of Masonic Lodge #597 F. & A.M., Clarington; Sardis Light Committee; and the Sardis United Methodist Church.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by two brothers, Ken Ivey and John Alan Ivey.
