Mullett, C. June, 93, of New Martinsville, WV, died Friday, November 14, 2014 at Sundale Nursing Home, Morgantown, WV.

She was born July 8, 1921 in New Martinsville, the daughter of the late Claude D. and Blanche Daugherty Moore.
