Carl E. Muldrew, 82, of Moundsville, died Sunday, January 31, 2016 at Reynolds Memorial Hospital.

He was born February 23, 1933 in Rosbys Rock, Marshall County, the son of the late Joseph Junior and Nettie Mae Conner Muldrew.

Carl was one of seven children, including Kenneth Muldrew, Katheryn Fritzman, Naomi Albright, Maxine Stern, Beuna Rader, and Mary Pathjesic.

He was a retired sheet metal worker from Union Local #33; US Marine Corporal, serving in Korea; and a Protestant by faith.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife Barbara Muldrew.

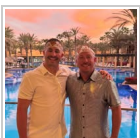
