Carl Edgar Walters, age 85 passed away Monday, March 11, 2024, at Sturgill Hospice House in Brooksville, FL.

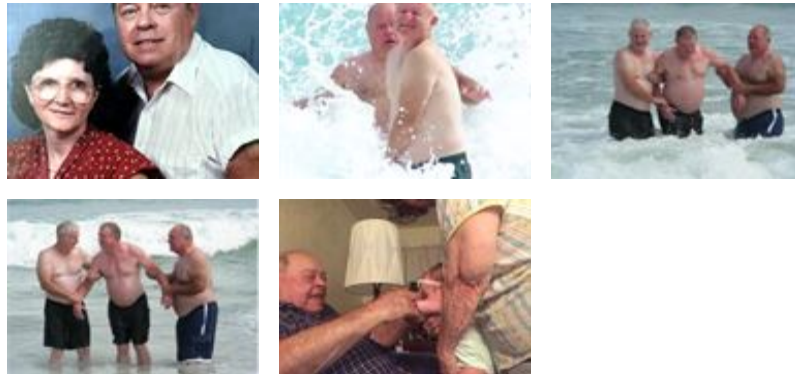
