Carol Ann Isenberg Pyle, age 73, passed away peacefully August 26, 2019 at Liza's Place, Wheeling, WV. Born November 3, 1945 in Ephrata, PA to Harry W. "Jim" and Marcella Isenberg, Carol graduated from Ephrata High School in 1963 and Millersville State College in 1967.

She was a high school English teacher, but left to join the family business, working with her mother for a decade. Her main career was as a copyeditor, specializing in biomedicine and mathematics. Carol was a talented musician, choosing to return her gift to the glory of God as a church organist. Beginning at age 16, she served many congregations during her life, including Messiah Lutheran Church, Moundsville.

Carol rescued greyhounds, one of which was a certified therapy dog for Alzheimer's units. She loved to sew and researched family genealogy going back to the early 1700s. She moved to Glen Dale in 2010 to be closer to her daughter.

Carol is survived by daughter, Annie VonNeida and grandson, Thomas Eisa Andrich. She leaves many friends from her church family, cherished cousins, and four dear friends from college that remained close for over 50 years.

Funeral service will be held Saturday, August 31st at 11am at Trinity Lutheran Church, 3536 Eoff Street, Wheeling.
