She was born August 4, 1933 in Marshall County, WV. She was a member and trustee of Limestone United Methodist Church, their pianist and organist for over 50 years. Carol was a 1951 graduate of Moundsville High School and continued her education at the College of Commerce in Wheeling. Carol was the Warden's secretary at the West Virginia Penitentiary from 1954 to 1959. Carol was Editor of the Wetzel County History Book-1983. She was past president of the Wetzel County Genealogical Society. Carol was Circuit Clerk of Wetzel County from 1993 to 1998. She was past Worthy Matron and past secretary of the Order of the Eastern Star #50. She enjoyed reading and genealogy.

In addition to her parents, Roy and Anna (Hunt) Rush, she was preceded in death by her husband, Charles W. Hassig in 1986.
