Cartwright, Jack E., age 79, of Paden City, WV, died Wednesday, April 17, 2013 at Wetzel County Hospital, New Martinsville, WV.

He was born August 14, 1933 in New Haven, WV, the son of the late William and Kathorene Wolf Cartwright.

Jack was a retired steelworker at Weirton Steel, a member of the Steelton Church of Christ in New Martinsville, and a U.S. Navy veteran of the Korean Conflict. He played for Ernest Tubb's record shop, a TV show in Oak Hill, WV and the Wheeling Jamboree. He loved to sing and had a number 1 hit song, "One Minute". Jack was also awarded a certificate for singing country music for 50 years.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a sister, Ruth Ann Love.
