Charles A. "Chuck" Anderson, age 69 of Moundsville, WV passed away on Saturday, October 1, 2022 at WVU Medicine-Ruby Memorial Hospital.

He was born June 2, 1953 in Glen Dale, WV the son of the late Thomas Allen and Helen Jean Yeater Anderson.

Chuck graduated from John Marshall High School in 1971 and began working at Fostoria Glass Co., he would later work as a truck driver and work the oil fields in Texas, but he spent most of his working life as a coal miner, a proud member of the UMWA he worked at various coal mines and would eventually retire from Consol Coal.

He loved wildlife and the outdoors, especially hunting and feeding his birds. He enjoyed fishing the ponds with his late wife, Corrine and was an avid Mountaineer and Steelers fan.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Corrine Anderson.
