



Charles "Charlie" W. Hartzell

June 7, 1941 - January 30, 2017

Charles "Charlie" W. Hartzell age 75, a lifelong Cameron, WV resident, died January 30, 2017 in Marietta Memorial Hospital after battling Alzheimer's Disease for several years.

He was born June 7, 1941 in Cameron, the son of the late John William and Lucy Keenan Hartzell.

He graduated from Cameron High School in 1960 and married the love of his life, Joanne in 1962; was a US Navy Veteran, having served aboard the USS Little Rock with tours in the Mediterranean Sea and the Honor Guard in Washington, DC; and was a retiree of PPG Industries, Natrium, WV where he retired in 2001 after 35 years of service.

Following his retirement, he took several camping trips out West, treating his grandchildren with an opportunity of a lifetime seeing the Grand Canyon, Yellowstone National Park, thunder snow in June at Jackson Hole, WY, and fished the Snake River; and he loved to hunt, fish, and camp with his family. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a brother, Ronnie Hartzell, a sister, Betty Sue Hartzell Ernest; and a daughter, Laurie Hartzell Murphy.

Survivors include his wife of 54 years, Joanne Stephens Hartzell; his children, Tim (Leslie) Hartzell, Tracey (Michael) Anderson, and Heather (Brent) Clark; a sister, Carol Ann Hartzell Stern; seven grandchildren; and six great-grandchildren.
