Crow, Charles K., age 88 of Glen Easton, WV died Wednesday, September 3, 2014, surrounded by his family.

He was born July 25, 1926 in Mason County, WV the son of the late Raleigh and Grace Jordon Crow.

He was a US Navy Reserve Veteran and a graduate of the US Merchant Marine Academy; a retired engineer with AEP; a member of Oak Grove United Methodist Church; a Sunday School teacher for many years and at many locations; a former city of Moundsville Councilman; and was very active with the Moundsville Little League; a member and lay speaker with Gideon's of Southwestern Michigan; and was an avid golfer.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a son, Paul Crow; a sister, Frances Markey; two brothers, William and Bob Crow; a son-in-law, Jerry Samples; two granddaughters; a grandson; and a great-grandson.

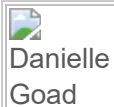
