Charles V. "Charlie" Eller, age 91, formerly of Washington Lands, died Tuesday, July 11, 2017 in Peterson Rehabilitation Hospital, Wheeling, WV. He was born May 9, 1926 on Taylor's Ridge, Moundsville, WV the son of the late Berrell and Florence Blake Eller.

He was a WWII Army Veteran, having served with the 1st Horse Cavalry; a retired Land Surveyor for Marshall County for over 40 years, and former President of WV Land Surveyors Association License #39; a former employee with both Fostoria Glass and Allied Chemical; a Methodist by faith; and a member of Washington Lands Lions Club.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Barbara Eller; and a brother, Ralph Eller; and a sister, Clarice Stanley.
