Charles E. Hart, age 89 of Jacobsburg, OH, formerly of Clarington, OH joined his beloved wife on Thursday, February 8, 2018.

He was born November 11, 1928 in Wetzel County, New Martinsville, WV, the son of the late Frederick Leroy and Eloise Gae Lemons Hart.

He was a Korean War Army Veteran; a previous member of The International Carpenter's Union of Wheeling and a retired employee from Ormet, with over 25 years of service, where he worked as a pot man and crane operator; a member of Old Wegee United Methodist Church, Pipe Creek and New Hope United Methodist Church's, where he served as a Sunday School Teacher, a certified Lay Speaker, and sat on numerous committees.

Charles was a "Jack of all Trades"; a farmer, laborer on construction, carpenter, and electrician.
