January 5, 1963 - July 20, 2022

Charles E. Yeater, born January 5, 1963, to Ruth and Paul Yeater, passed away Tuesday, July 20, 2022, at his favorite place, his log cabin home on Rines Ridge, where he enjoyed hunting, his cat Leo, and working on the farm. Charlie grew up in Moundsville, WV and joined the Navy as a young man to see the world and serve his country. Charlie served for over 20 years on the aircraft carriers Nimitz, America, and Enterprise, becoming an E-9 Master Chief Petty Officer. At different times he was the instructor for the Norfolk Naval Fire School and was in charge of the flight deck on the US Enterprise. Charlie saw action during Desert Storm and the Kosovo-Bosnia conflict and was in his office at the Pentagon on 9/11/2001. He received many medals, including the Navy-Marine Corps Commendation Medal and Navy-Marine Corps Medal for Heroism and was personally discharged by George W. Bush in the Oval Office at the end of his career.

After returning to Moundsville, Charlie earned a BS in industrial electronics and finished his work career as a Sr. Technician at Warren Distribution in Glen Dale, WV.

Charlie is survived by his life partner, Mary Mattone, and her children, Seth (Callie Cox) and Adam (Jesse) Robinson; three brothers, David, Terry, and Ron, all of Moundsville; one sister, Lisa (Greg) Marquart of Bethlehem; nieces and nephews, Amber Yeater (Sandy), Brandy (Katherine) Yeater, Natalie and Adam Marquart, and great niece Julia Myers.
