Crow, George Robert, "Uncle Bob" passed away in Bay Pines Veterans Hospital in St. Petersburg, FL on 5/23/2007.

He was born in Martins Ferry, OH, the son of the late Raleigh Courtland and Grace V. Jordan Crow.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a brother, William Crow of Costa Rica, a sister, Frances Markey of Cleveland, OH; a nephew, Paul Crow of Glen Dale, WV and a niece Victoria Crow of Costa Rica.

Survivors include a brother, Charles K. (Jane) Crow of Glen Easton, WV; three nephews, Mike Crow of Glen Dale, Mark (Mandy) Crow of Moundsville, WV and John (Amy) Crow of Indianapolis, and three nieces; Sue (Jerry) Samples of Chicago, Margaret (Greg) Knight of Cameron, WV and Terri (Bill) Ferguson of Glen Easton.

Bob is also survived by his Indian family; Jeevan and Esther Nair of Bangalore, India and their children; Priya of Toronto, Canada and Pradeep of Moundsville; and many close friends throughout the world.

He was raised in Letart, WV; graduated from Wahama High School in Mason County, WV and The University of Chicago. He attended WVU, graduated from Moody Bible Institute in Chicago and served as a Corporal in the US Army.

Uncle Bob was a missionary in India for over 50 years. He founded Grace Ministries in 1984 and served as President until his recent retirement. The main goal of the ministry is to translate the Bible into the 14 main languages of

India. He translated and published a Telegu Study Bible, an English Study Bible, several books and Grace Ministries; under the leadership of Pastor Jeevan Nair; who continues to translate the Bible into other Indian languages. Uncle Bob was a well renowned Pastor in India where many considered him "The Billy Graham of India". He was an award-winning poet and many of his books continue to be published today.
