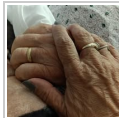

“ Growing up in Lynn Camp, WV was quite adventurous at times, but quiet at times, and fun. Cy always had a smile on his face since he was a baby, my Dad said always a happy kid, no matter what. One adventure I remember with Cy, was when we thought we lost him in the hole in the road by the bridge. We got off the bus to walk to our houses, but there was this hole we had been watching get bigger everyday in the road nearby the bridge, and it happened to be bigger than ever that day. Vicki was in high school and she had stayed in Cameron that day after school. She would have tried to stop what we were about to do. We all looked into the hole and we were quite amazed how big it was. Cy being the adventurous one decided he would go down in the hole. Well, he held on to the top of the road, and yelled up and told us it was dark down there but he could see parts of the bridge under the road. He said he could see a little light from the hole, but overall it was pretty dark. Now, really did we need to know that. I guess at the time it was something that needed to be done, for a bunch of grade school kids. So, after he investigated for all of us, he could not get himself out. We, girls were scared we were going to lose him into the hole in the road, so we all pitched in, he grabbed our hands and we pulled him out. I think we were all scared and relieved at that time he was safe. Even adventurous Cy. Cy was the first to get his driving license, he had football practice, we girls had band practice. Cy seemed to like to drive a little on the fast side, but we would never tell. One day we were going down Jones Hill into Cameron, and Cy decided to light a cigarette, but he dropped it some way onto the door by him, and he was trying to get hold of it before it burnt his arm, needless to say while he was looking for the cigarette, he swerved towards the edge of the road. I think we all screamed, he looked up, caught the cigarette, grabbed the wheel, got the scout back on the road. Got after us for not grabbing the wheel, kept driving, never slowed down for the entire thing. We just went on to band practice. So, I guess he was quite talented, too. We would never ever tell on him for smoking, either. He was our best bud. Cy fell from his horse, Tony, I think he was in grade school. He said it was not the horses fault, it was raining and muddy and Cy was riding him He rode that horse

all the time. I think all the people in Lynn Camp.were.there to help him. The ambulances back then could not get across the bridge, because of the water was flooding and roaring over the bridge,or drive up to where Cy was, because it was so terribly muddy. I think Cork, Cy' s Dad made a wooden backboard for him and he was carried out of the field and to the ambulance. It took quite a while ,I think to get him to the ambulance. He was in the hospital for a while, but he came home in about a week or longer it seemed. Problem was he had a half body cast on for about sixweeks. The summer was hot that year. I think we used to fan him to cool off. He probably had an electric fan, but maybe not. I am not sure, but we girls may have tormented him a little bit, BUT, we waited on him very well for the most part. Like I said earlier he was our best buddy. Just a few of the adventures we had growing up together. He always had that smile and laughter then, no matter what the adventure was. Memories we all can keep of Cy.
