Dale Edward Hoffman, age 87, of Wheeling passed away Wednesday, March 22, 2017 surrounded by his family.

He was born May 26, 1929, in Wheeling, the son of the late John Wilber and Anna Marie Wolf Hoffman.

Dale was a retired foreman at Picoma Industries, owner of the Hoffman Machine Shop for 15 years, where he assisted in the development of special parts for NASA. He attended Linsly School where he played football until an injury ended his participation. He graduated from Triadelphia High School in 1948. He was a member of Elm Grove United Methodist Church and a veteran of the US Navy Reserves. He enjoyed singing, playing the guitar and fishing with family and friends in Canada for years. He enjoyed spending time with his son-in-law Dr. Templeton at toughman contests and pro boxing matches. He was also an avid collector of model antique cars.

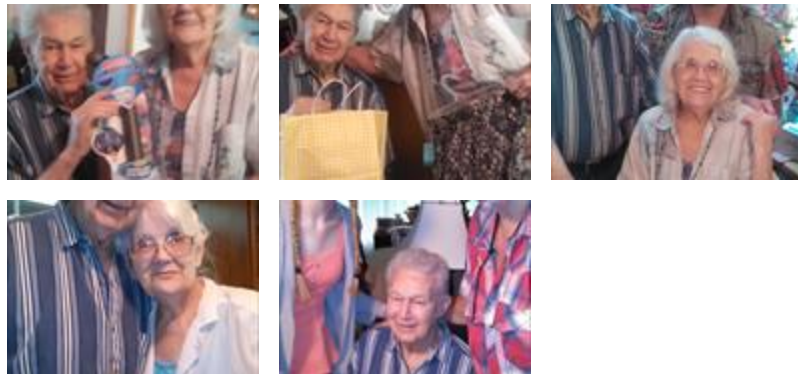
