February 26, 1915 - April 15, 2015

McMahon, Dale Mason., age 100 of Glen Dale, WV died Wednesday, April 15, 2015 in Reynolds Memorial Hospital, Glen Dale.

He was born February 26, 1915 in Glen Dale, the son of the late Joseph R. and Olive Mason McMahon.

He was a WWII Navy Veteran, having been stationed on Aleutian Islands, Island of Attu; a retired manufacturing manager from Triangle Conduit; the "oldest member" of Glen Dale United Methodist Church; a former Glen Dale City Councilman; a member of Moundsville Elks #282, Moundsville VFW Post #437; and the American Electro Platers Society.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Doris McMahon; three brothers, Glenn, Deane, and Donald McMahon; two sisters, Geneva Mobley, and Juanita Fahey; and an infant son, Sheldon McMahon. Survivors include a son, D. Keith (Jerilyn) McMahon of Homosassa, FL; a daughter, Sheila (Gary) Langfitt of Glen Dale; a brother, Noel (June) McMahon of Vero Beach, FL; a sister-in-law, Estella McMahon of Atlanta, GA; five grandchildren; and six great-grandchildren.

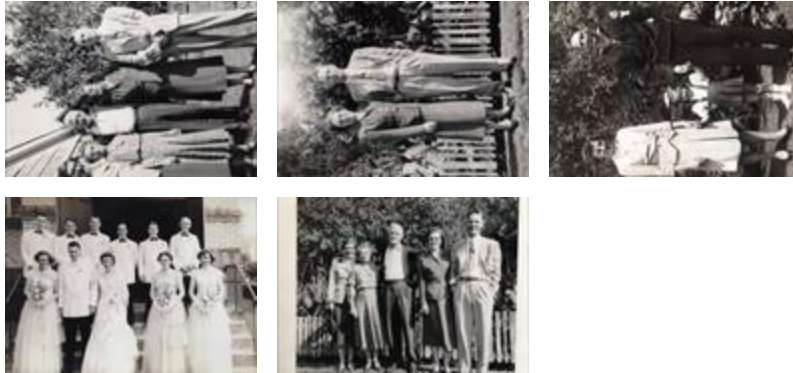
