Morris, Danny, 71, of New Martinsville, WV, died Monday, February 03, 2014 at Wetzel County Hospital, New Martinsville.

He was born December 6, 1942 in Littleton, WV, a son of the late Glen I. Morris and Beryl Lambert Morris Pratt.

Danny was a retired maintenance foreman at Ormet; a member of American Legion Post 28, New Martinsville; VFW #9930, Duffy, Ohio; Middlebourne Lodge #34 A.F. & A.M.; American Quarter Horse Association; and a lifetime member of the Belgian Draft Horse Corp. of America. 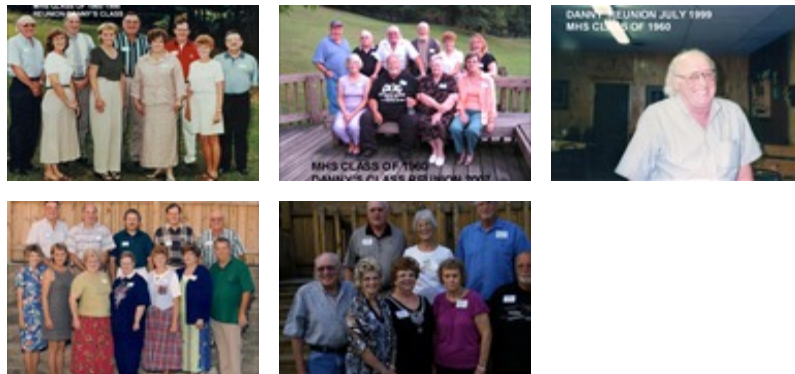
