David Orest Mason, age 67 of Moundsville, WV died Sunday, August 21, 2016 at home.

He was born February 26, 1949 in Moundsville, the son of the late Orest Mason and Marjorie Burge McClelland.

He was a Vietnam Army Veteran; a former employee and union president of Triangle Conduit, Glen Dale; a retired employee from Wheeling Hospital Medical Park; and an avid farmer.
