Rev. Dennis A. Mehaffie, 62, of Moundsville, WV, died Friday, December 11, 2020 at UPMC- Presbyterian.

He was born May 28, 1958 in Clearfield, PA; the son of the late Paul and Frances Passmore Mehaffie.

Dennis was a minister with the United Methodist Church Conference; member of Moundsville Area Ministerial Association; Light of Faith Christian Bible Institute; graduate from Asbury Seminary; he loved camping, fishing, spending time with his family and friends, his most treasured moments were reading to his daughter Elane.
