



## Dolores J. Dinger

June 24, 1928 - February 26, 2015

Dinger, Dolores J., age 86, of New Martinsville, WV, died Thursday, February 26, 2015 at Acuity Specialty Hospital, Bellaire, Ohio.

She was born June 24, 1928 in Tiltonsville, Ohio, a daughter of the late Benjamin J. and Wilma Fluxe Sadowski.

Dolores used to work at the former W.T. Grant store in New Martinsville and was a glass finisher at the former Imperial Glass Company. She was a member of the First Baptist Church in New Martinsville; Canasta Club, a bowler, belonged to Weight Watchers; and was a walker for Relay for Life.

She will be remembered best for her kind nature, a woman of very strong faith and the scriptures, her infectious laugh and her love of all types of Rock and Roll music, starting with Elvis to contemporary groups, having attended more than a few concerts for the past decades.

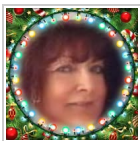
