Don W. Crow, formerly of Moundsville, West Virginia was reunited with his wife Shirleen (Robinson) Crow on Sunday, January 12th in Worthington Ohio. He was born on September 15, 1928 in Moundsville, West Virginia, son of the late Wesley and Elizabeth Crow.

Don was a devoted husband, father, and pap who cherished his family above all else. A US Army veteran and former employee of Allied Chemical and Olin Chemical Corporation. A skilled outdoorsman in his earlier years, after retiring he turned to golf and spent his days between family and honing his golf skills that made him a well known amateur golfer around the Ohio Valley, having competed in numerous local tournaments.

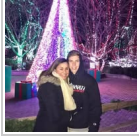
