Sinon, Donald Eugene, age 73 of Moundsville, WV died Tuesday, December 16, 2014 in Liza's Place, Wheeling, WV, surrounded by his loving family. He was born July 25, 1941 in Moundsville, the son of the late Daniel L. and Mary E. Riggs Sinon.
