E. Scott Howell, age 79, of Sardis, OH, passed away Sunday, February 8, 2026, at WVU Medicine Camden Clark Medical Center Parkersburg, WV. He was born August 15, 1946, in New Martinsville, WV, a son of the late Raymond and Ruth J. Gano Howell.

He was a former employee of Quarto Mining from 1977-1987. As a safety engineer, he was an advanced industrial fire school instructor with OSI Specialties. He instructed Hazmat training at Union Carbide as well. He retired from GE Plastics, where he was a safety engineer and a team member of the emergency response team for 15 years. During his working time, he also won the 2001 WV Safety Council Professional of the Year award. He helped start the Sardis Emergency Squad and was a member of the Sardis Volunteer Fire Dept, Sardis Methodist Church and First Congregational Church in Marietta, OH.

Scott was a loving dedicated husband, father, and grandfather. He loved his animals and his Jeeps. He also loved cooking for others and was a guest cook at Marv's in Sardis, a few times.

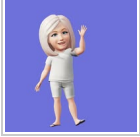
