Ebert, W. Norbert, age 74 of New Martinsville, WV, died Friday July 10, 2009 at his home.

He was born October 12, 1934 in Wetzel County, West Virginia, the son of the late Edward George and Alma Stern Ebert.

He was a US Army veteran and a member of St. Ann's Episcopal Church.

He was retired glass worker of 29.5 years from Corning Glass; owner/operator of Ebert Enterprises; Town and Country Days director for over 40 years; founder of Ebert Brothers Shows, performing for 41 years; competed in several local and state fiddle contests; hosted several benefit shows for the community; performed at WV State Park Tour, Indian River Festival in Titusville, Florida, and numerous other venues; hosted Scholars of Dollars; involved in the Easter Seals Telethon; and in his own words "I loved playing the fiddle and entertaining the family".

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a brother Drexel Poe.
