Edith Trevey Davis, age 99, formerly of Shadyside, OH died Sunday, June 19, 2016 at Trinity Community Retirement Center, Beavercreek, OH.

She was born November 14, 1916 near Moundsville, WV to the late Otis and Eva Sims Trevey. She graduated from Mt Union University in music and was Kappa Delta sorority president.
