



## Edwin R Hohmann

August 23, 1929 - January 12, 2015

Hohmann, Edwin R., 85, of Proctor, WV, died Monday, January 12, 2015 at his home.

He was born August 23, 1929 in Proctor, the son of the late Clem and Hilda Montgomery Hohman.

Edwin was a retired lineman for Monongalia Power Company and a farmer. He was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Proctor, American Legion Post 28, New Martinsville, and a U.S. Army veteran of the Korean War for which he was awarded the Korean Service Medal with 2 Bronze Stars and the United Nations Service medal.
