Eleanor I. Hahle, age 100, of Bethlehem was reunited with her husband, of 60 years, on Tuesday, September 27, 2016.

She was born November 18, 1915 in Sherrard, WV, the daughter of the late Oscar and Ollie Myrtle Morgan Talbert.

Eleanor was important to many people. She was a hard-working daughter on her family's farm, a retired Executive Secretary for the West Virginia State Road Commission, a member of the Bethlehem Presbyterian Church and the Miriam Chapter Order of the Eastern Star.

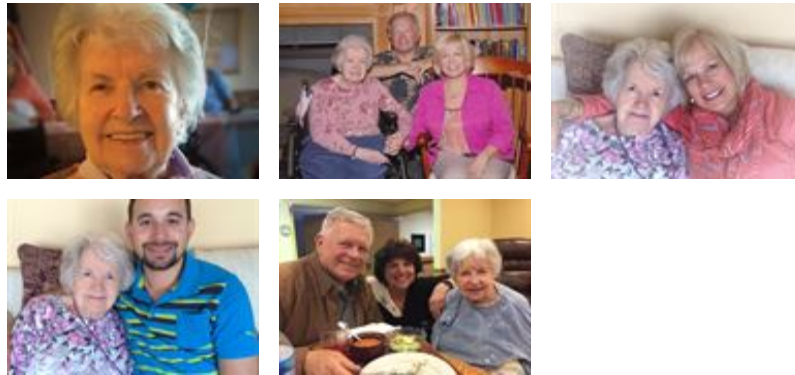
