Elizabeth Willey Robison, age 77 of Moundsville died Tuesday, February 10, 2015 at home.

She was born April 30, 1937 in Wetzel County, WV daughter of the late Lonnie and Amelia Hartline Willey.

Elizabeth was a retired teacher from the First Ward and Central Elementary Schools, a member of the Hillview Terrace Church of Christ, Moundsville where she was a Bible class teacher for 50 years. She was an avid Bible student and loved her Lord and His church. She was a volunteer librarian for the WV School of Preaching for 17 years, loved music, reading, grammar, spending quality time with her family, and collecting penguins.

In addition to her parents she was preceded in death by her husband, A. Jack Robison.
