Elizabeth J. "Betty June" Wymer, age 79 of Bethlehem, WV passed away Wednesday, June 26, 2019 at home.

She was born in Berlin, PA the daughter of the late George and Florence Philson Dively.

She was a registered nurse at WVU Medical Center and Ohio Valley Medical Center.

Betty June was a graduate of Berlin Brothers Valley High School and Memorial Hospital School of Nursing. She was a member of the WV Association of Museums, National Association of Warwick China, Wheeling Historical Society, Friends of Wheeling, Oglebay Institute, Barnstormers (Mail Pouch), Mary Martin Dorcas Questers, History Hero, recipient of the Citizenship Award from Bethlehem, WV and Volunteer of the year award from Disney. She volunteered thirty four years in Ohio County Schools and was a member of Grace Lutheran Church, formerly Zion Lutheran Church. Betty June loved her cats.

In addition to her parents she was preceded in death by four siblings, Bill Dively, Phyllis Smith, Tom Dively and Barb Craig.
