Justice, Francine Ann, 62, of New Martinsville, WV, died Monday, January 20, 2014 at home.

She was born October 19, 1951 in New Martinsville.

Francine was a registered nurse for 20 years, and a member of St. Vincent de Paul Catholic Church in New Martinsville. Her life centered around family, church and friends. Francine enjoyed boating, beach vacations, and also volunteered with Journey Hospice.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Francis and Rita Frohnappel Batton.

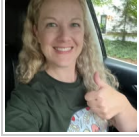

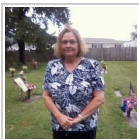
