Burkle, Francis Stanton “Stan”, of Moundsville, WV, known by many as “Catbird” passed away Wednesday, April 22, 2015 in Cumberland Pointe Care Center, St. Clairsville, OH, where he spent the last two years cared for by loving and thoughtful caregivers.

Stan was born in Wheeling, WV on December 2, 1918, the son of the late Edward and Mayme Whyte Burkle.

He was a retired self employed floor installer and master craftsman and took great pride in his work.
