Francis "Edward" Masarick, age 83 of Bellaire, OH died Monday, October 7, 2019 in Liza's Place, Wheeling, WV.

He was born January 28, 1936 in Bellaire, the son of the late Francis Joseph and Rose Theresa Klempa Masarick.

He was a US Marine Veteran; a member of St. John's Catholic Church; had worked for 22 years as a Lab Worker at Ohio Ferro Alloy; was a Valley Voyager Captain for 16 years; and worked for the City of Bellaire for 20 years. He loved watching sports, going to Wheeling Downs; and working on his own home.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Mary Lou Greenwood Masarick in 2016; and a sister, Patricia Feola.
